How much does it cost?

Membership fee: Personal membership for 2024-25 is £140, less than the cost of a cup of coffee per week

Meetings: We meet fortnightly at the Early Bird in Grove Green for an informal, single course dinner. Most members attend regularly. However, there is no minimum attendance requirement and if people prefer to come along for just a coffee or drink and join in the social and business aspects of the evening, they are very welcome.

Donations: Members are encouraged, although not expected, to donate when they can to appeals and events although there is no minimum expectation. Your time, company and willingness to take part in things are the most important thing.
